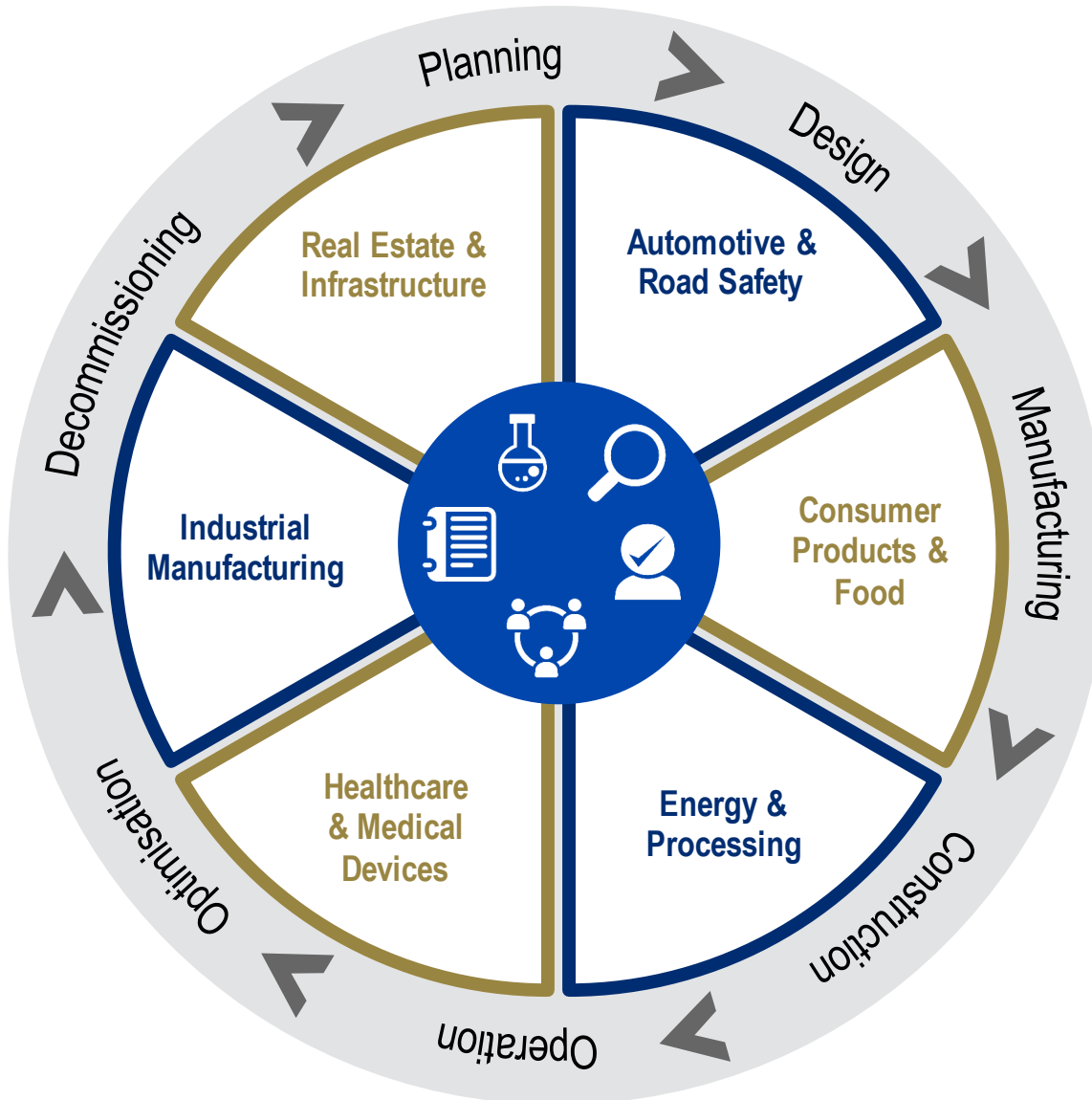

Energy Efficiency

To support the BMW Group's ambitious targets for economical energy use, the energy efficiency analyses we undertook at its manufacturing plant in Rosslyn, South Africa, identified 28 potential areas for energy savings that were organised in a catalogue of proposed actions.

Offshore wind energy

From monitoring of manufacturing, transport, erection / installation and commissioning of the entire offshore wind farm to operational release approval from the responsible German authority, our experts ensured that all components conform to given requirements in order to mitigate operational risk in the certification of a new offshore wind farm, Nordsee One.



Urbanisation

The world's urban population is on the rise. For the first time in history, more of us live in cities than rural areas. Cities present immense challenges in terms of energy, water, housing, safety and transportation.

Expansion beyond Europe began with a cable car accident investigation in Cape Town, South Africa.



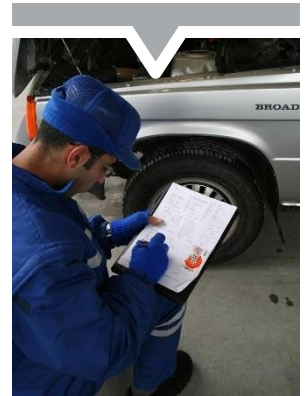
1991

1996

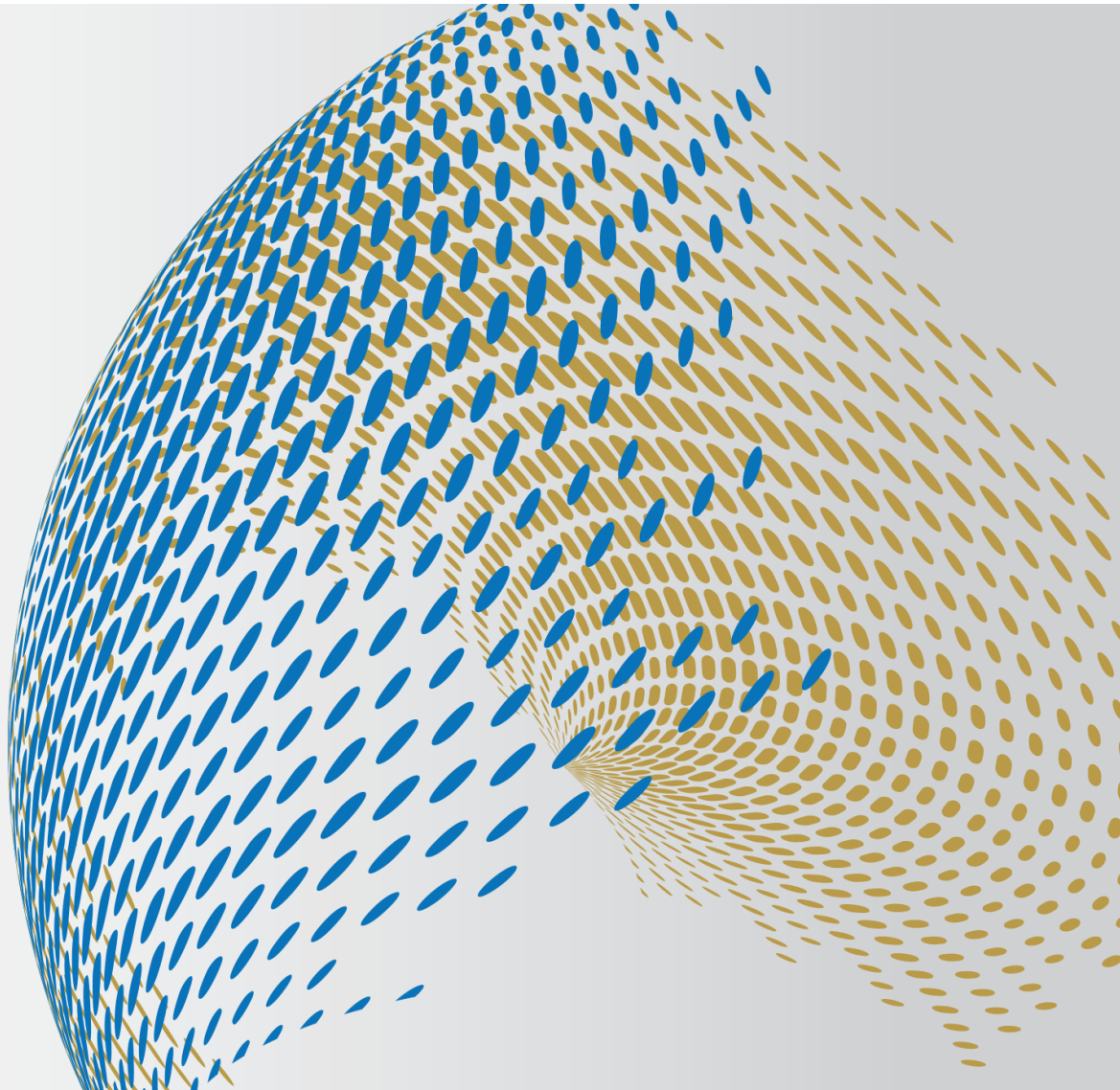

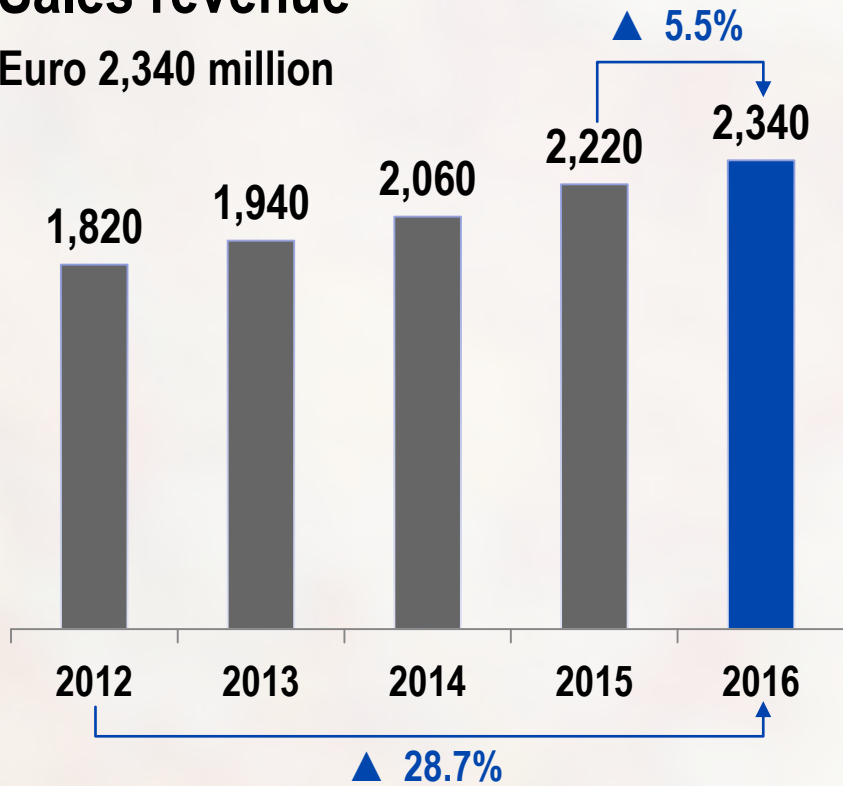

Sales revenue

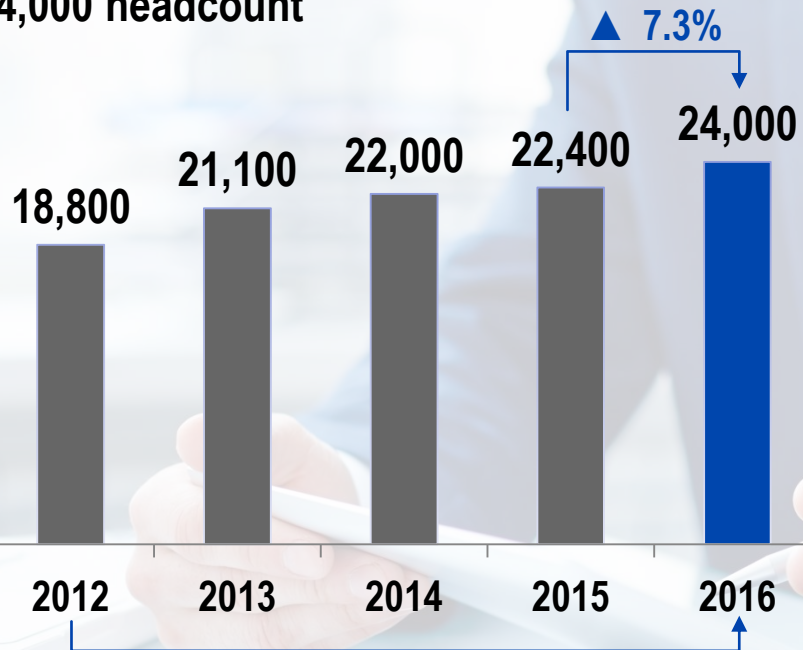

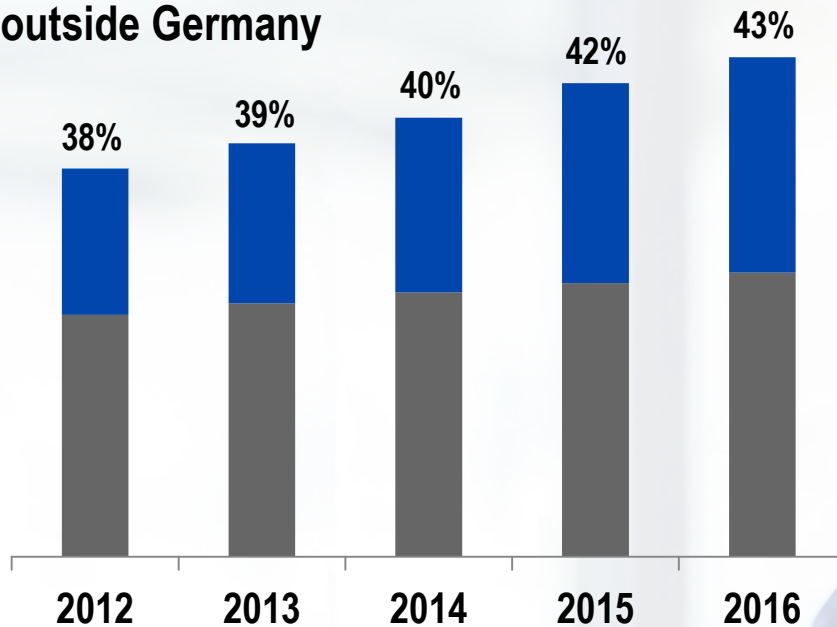

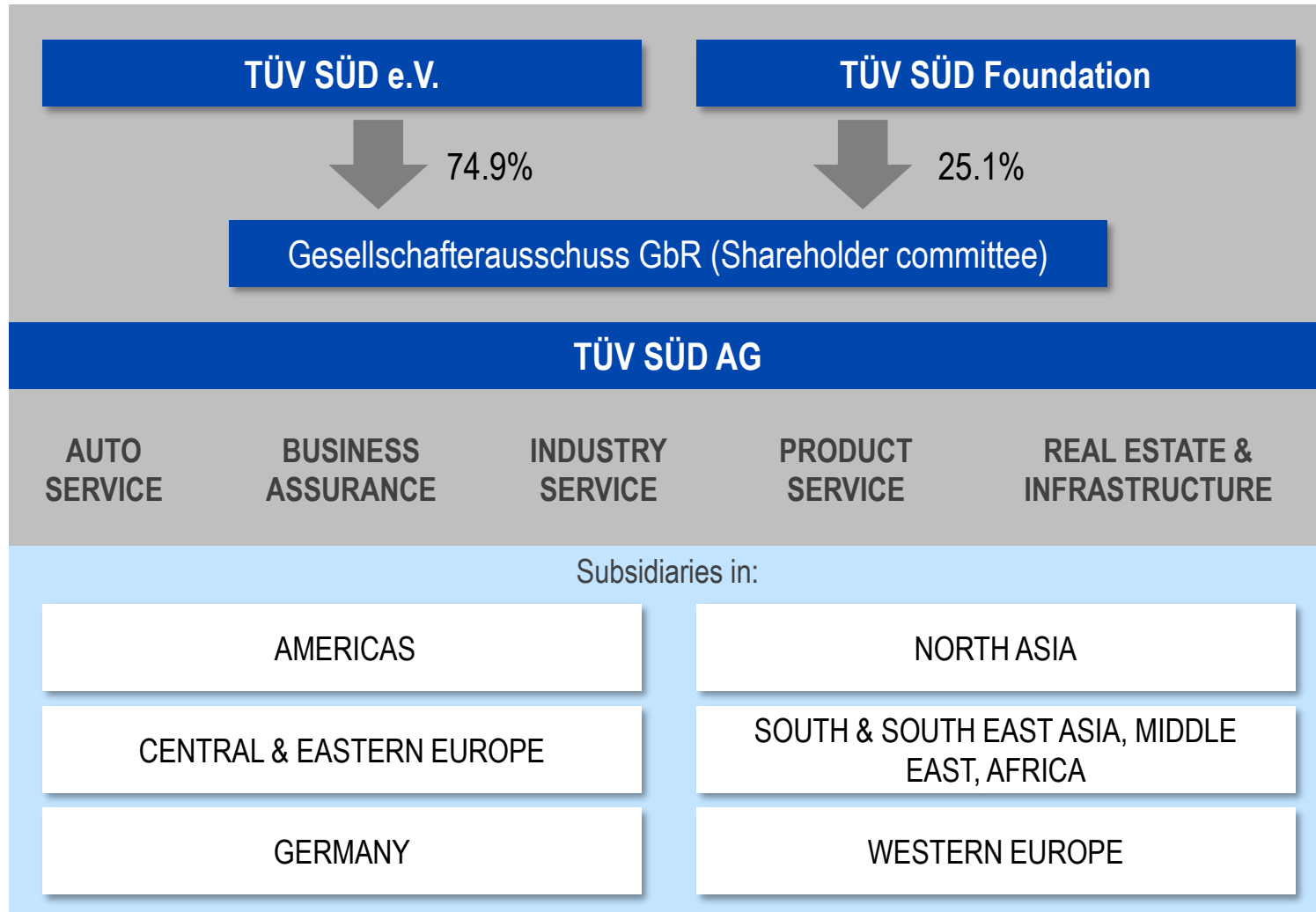
